Individuals who qualify for assistance will meet with New Mexico lawyers who will provide free, limited legal advice and assistance. This clinic is primarily for survivors/victims from Colfax, Lincoln, Mora, San Miguel, Valencia counties.

**Attorneys will be able to provide advice regarding various legal issues related to the fires to include but not limited to:**

- Assistance with securing FEMA and other benefits available to disaster survivors
- Assistance with life, medical, and property insurance claims
- Help with home repair contracts and contractors
- Replacement of important legal documents destroyed in the disaster
- Assistance with consumer protection matters, remedies, and procedures
- Counseling on landlord/tenant and mortgage/foreclosure problems
- Other legal issues such as bankruptcy, civil rights, insurance, family law, and employment law
