The position will focus on complex consumer protection investigations and litigation. Interested candidates should have substantive experience in major complex civil litigation in both state and federal courts at the trial and appellate levels. The position will also work with environmental enforcement attorneys to bring cross disciplinary actions. The ideal candidate will have superior research and drafting skills, be comfortable in a court setting and have the ability to build consensus and work with many disparate interests. Applicants should be self-motivated and possess the ability to work alone and as part of a team. A minimum of 7 years of civil litigation experience is preferred. Applicants must hold an active license in good standing to practice in New Mexico, or be eligible to seek a public employee limited license for government service.
