AG Balderas, Sheriff Gonzales, HSI & APD Announce Seven Arrests in Underage Human Trafficking Operation

*Seven men arrested for soliciting sex with who they thought was
a 15-year-old girl*

Albuquerque, NM – Today, Attorney General Hector Balderas, Bernalillo County Sheriff Manny Gonzales, Homeland Security Investigations and the Albuquerque Police Department announced the successful result of a joint operation targeting commercial sex trafficking of minors in Albuquerque. Seven men were arrested this week in Albuquerque during the operation for soliciting sex with someone they believed to be a 15-year-old girl, who was actually an undercover BCSO deputy. The men all attempted to pay \$40 to \$200 to have sex with 15-year-old girls.

The Albuquerque office of Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) led the multi-agency operation, which began July 17. The four-day operation also focused on consumers of underage prostitutes, and rescuing victims, which included juveniles.

“There is no higher priority than protecting our children from sexual violence and dangerous sexual predators, and I want to thank all of the agencies that worked together on this successful operation to combat the trafficking of children in New Mexico,” said **Attorney General Hector Balderas**.

“Operation Recovery is a collaboration between BCSO, HSI, APD and the New Mexico Attorney General. I truly believe in the effort to advocate for victims who have been forced into a life of sex trafficking and placed in a position to restore stability in their life. This partnership has proven to be fruitful in targeting sex traffickers who prey on minors. Let this be a notice to those who participate in sex trafficking that law enforcement will hold you accountable,” said **Bernalillo County Sheriff Manuel Gonzales III**.

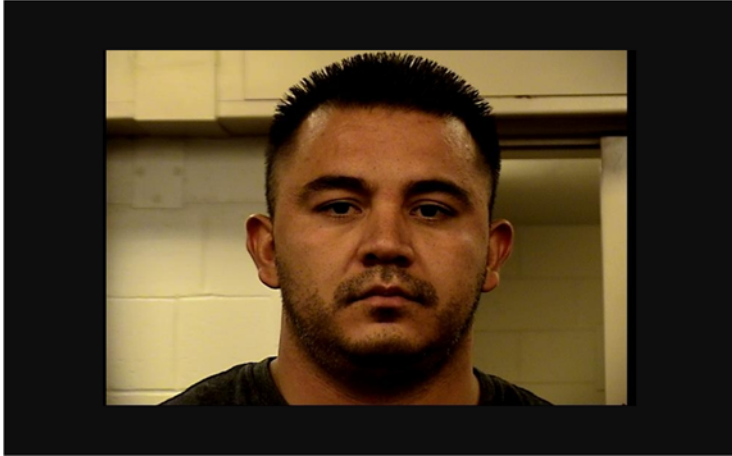

special agent in charge of HSI El Pasosaid. Rodriguez oversees HSI operations in west Texas and the entire state of New Mexico.

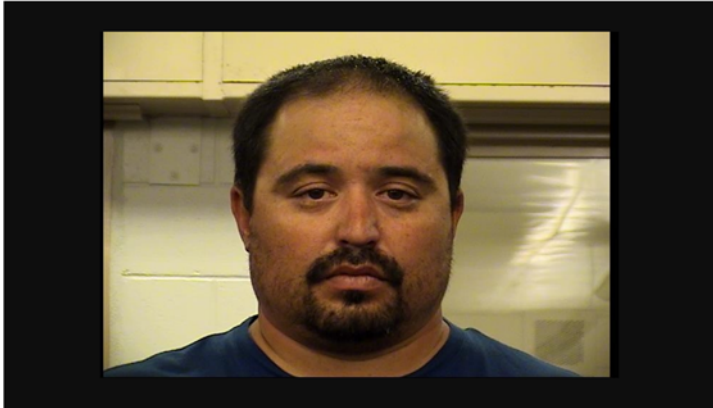

CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 19th day of July, 2017, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (here state the essential facts):

On 7/19/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is commonly sought out and contact was made with, Christopher Goularet, age 31. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Goularet responded to the ad using the phone number (417) 327-0408 at approximately 1820 hours. During the text conversation the female advised that she was underage by stating, "140 for both. We kiss. Your not a cop right? We're both 15 so we can't mess with law." During the conversation Goularet stated "Im not a cop are u a cop or working with them" Conversation continued between Goularet and the perceived female child. Goularet asked the perceived female child "Rate hhr.....And that's both u. And full service. Do u kiss" I know through training and experience "full service" to be slang for sexual intercourse. An agreement was made with the perceived 15 year old for sexual intercourse in exchange for \$100. Goularet was given a location to meet which is being concealed at this time based on an ongoing undercover operation but is in the city of Albuquerque. At 1900 hours Goularet indicated via text message that he had arrived. He then met with the undercover deputy, who appears young, in a room. Goularet verbally confirmed that he was seeking "full service" meaning sexual intercourse in exchange for \$100 in cash. Goularet was arrested on scene.

Goularet was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Goularet stated that he was on backpage.com due to advice from a friend. Goularet stated that he was texting several females advertised on the website. Goularet stated that he arrived after agreeing to have "full service" with the females. He stated that he knew full service to be "sex." I asked Goularet if the age of the females was discussed and he admitted that it came up several times, and he knew it to be 15. Goularet stated that he was told by his friend that girls will sometimes say they are young to attract customers but are actually older. Goularet stated that when the female stated that she was 15 in person he was about to back out, but was arrested before he could. He denied having sexual interest in underage females. While asking questions about the process, Goularet stated several times "I did it. I walked in the door." Goularet was transported for booking for the listed charges.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 18th day of July, 2017, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (*here state the essential facts*):

On 7/18/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is commonly sought out and contact was made with, William Long, age 31. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Long responded to the ad using the phone number (505) 366-4557 at approximately 1612 hours. During the text conversation the female advised that she was underage by stating, "Lol sorry have to be careful I'm 15 so I can't fuck with law." During the conversation Long stated "Please don't get me in trouble. Im actually a very good guy.....I'll go to prison though lol. But ill trust you :)" Conversation continued between Long and the undercover female. Long asked the undercover female, "would you accept a donation of 60, for BB qv? Lol I mean BB (bareback)." I know through training and experience "bareback" to be slang for sexual intercourse without a condom and "qv" to be quick visit. An agreement was made with the perceived 15 year old for sexual intercourse without a condom in exchange for \$60. Long was given a location to meet which is being concealed at this time based on an ongoing undercover operation but is in the city of Albuquerque. At 1702 hours Long indicated via text message that he had arrived. He then met with the undercover deputy, who appears young, in a room. Long verbally confirmed that he was seeking "full service" meaning sexual intercourse in exchange for \$60 in cash. Long was arrested on scene.

Long was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Long stated that he found the ad on a website that prostitutes solicit themselves in exchange for money. Long stated that he had text communication with the female and arrived. I asked Long if there was any conversation about age. He stated that there was not. I confronted Long about the perceived child stating twice in the text that she was 15. He stated that 15 was in response to time offered and not age. I asked about when the age was mentioned in the context of getting in trouble and not time. Long stated that he was nervous and maintained that he did not know the age to be 15. Long was arrested and booked per the listed charges.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 20th day of July, 2017, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (*here state the essential facts*):

On 7/20/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is commonly sought out and contact was made via text message with Vu Nguyen, age 27. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Nguyen responded to the ad using the phone number (505) 916-8951 at approximately 1820 hours. During the text conversation Nguyen asked "spk grk?" Through training and experience I know this to be an acronym for 'speak greek', which I know to be a slang term commonly used to describe anal sex. A price of \$200 was agreed upon. The undercover female advised via text message that she was underage by stating, "Only thing we kinda young. That cool." To which he replied "How young." And the undercover female responded "We both 15." Nguyen continued to negotiate a location to meet the two perceived fifteen year olds. Nguyen was given a location to meet which is being concealed at this time based on an ongoing undercover operation but is in the city of Albuquerque. At 1654 hours Nguyen indicated via text message that he had arrived. He then met with the undercover deputies, who appears young, in a room. Nguyen entered the room and began arguing with the undercover deputies, demanding that they touch him before he produced the money. During the argument Nguyen was arrested on scene. Upon search incident to arrest, Nguyen was found to have exactly \$200 in cash on his person and 4 condoms.

Nguyen was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Nguyen repeatedly stated he did not know why he "is here." Nguyen came to The Drury Hotel to possible rent a hotel room. While walking up and down the second floor walkway Nguyen was approached by a female, the undercover female, who asked if he wanted to come to her room. Nguyen told the undercover female yes. Nguyen denied reaching out to the undercover female and requesting "greek" in exchange for \$200. Nguyen was transported for booking for the listed charges.

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 17th day of July, 2017, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (*here state the essential facts*):

On 7/17/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is commonly sought out and contact was made with, Jacob Samora, age 28. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Samora responded to the ad using the phone number (505) 257-5263 at approximately 1420 hours. During the text conversation the female advised that she was underage by stating, "Only if your ok that I'm 15. Hate lying so I'm just straight up." Samora responded "Woah uhhh I don't know how much?" Conversation continued and Samora had previously asked for a "bj", which I know through training and experience to be slang for oral sex, reiterated that by responding to prices with "For jusy head." I also know head to be a slang term meaning oral sex. An agreement was made with the perceived 15 year old for oral sex in exchange for \$60. The price was later negotiated down to \$40. Samora was given a location to meet which is being concealed at this time based on an ongoing undercover operation but is in the city of Albuquerque. At 1641 hours Samora indicated that he had arrived via text message. He then met with the undercover deputy, who appears young in a room. Samora verbally confirmed that he was seeking oral sex in exchange for \$40 in cash. Samora was arrested on scene.

Samora was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Samora stated that he was communicating with a female from the website and agreed to sex in exchange for money. I asked Samora about the age of the female and he stated that he did not know it. When I stated that he was advised that she was 15 and he reacted to it via text, he stated that he had contacted several females on the site and was unsure. Samora stated that he had been communicating via the "Text Now" phone app and he granted permission to search the device which was located on his person at the time of arrest. Samora was transported for booking for the listed charges.

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 17th day of July, 2017, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (*here state the essential facts*):

On 7/17/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is commonly sought out and contact was made with, Richard Sanchez, age 47. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Sanchez responded to the ad using the phone number (505) 506-8382 at approximately 1503 hours. During the text conversation the female advised that she was underage by stating that she was "kinda young" then stating "Im 15." Sanchez responded by asking if the perceived child was a cop. Conversation continued via text message and Sanchez asked several times if he could "cum over." At approximately 1547 hours, Sanchez negotiated "60 for a hh." Through training and experience I know this agreement is commonly used in prostitution to set a price for an half an hour visit. At 1608 hours, Sanchez requested a phone call. The undercover deputy called and spoke to him, at which time he requested "full service." Through training and experience I know full service to mean full sexual intercourse and oral sex. Sanchez was given a pre-arranged meet location which I know to be in the city of Albuquerque, but is being concealed at this time due to ongoing proactive investigations. At approximately 1821 hours Sanchez indicated he had arrived via text message.

Sanchez met with the undercover female deputy and verbally agreed to the exchange of sex (full service) for \$60. Sanchez was arrested without incident.

Sanchez was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Sanchez stated he drove to the designated hotel to meet Kandi, whom he knew was 15 years old. Sanchez agreed to meet with Kandi because the hotel was located near his home therefore it was convenient to meet with her. Sanchez agreed to pay Kandi \$60 in exchange for full service, which he explained to me as full sex. Sanchez stated he is having difficulties with his wife at home, which is why he has been contacting prostitutes on backpage.com.

On 7/20/2017 Special Agents and Detectives were conducting an undercover online investigation regarding underage prostitution. During the investigation, an online ad was placed on a website where prostitution is advertised and contact was made via text message with Christ Sathoud, age 27. The ad was consistent with those placed on the website and used an undercover deputy who is young in appearance. Sathoud responded to the ad using the phone number (505) 315-0682 at approximately 1509 hours. During the text conversation Sathoud asked "So, you down to kick it and have some fun" The undercover officer replied, "what kinda fun?" Sathoud replied, "Adult type of fun." The undercover officer advised via text message that she was underage by stating, "Im only 15 but I can do adult fun." Sathoud replied, "No, that's risky... I don't wanna get in trouble." After further conversation Sathoud texted, "Ok, so I'm doing you both at the same time, threesome. Where are you right now?" Through training and experience I know "threesome" to be a slang term commonly used for sexual intercourse with three people. A price of \$60 was agreed upon. Sathoud was given a location to meet which was being concealed at this time based on an ongoing undercover operation, but is in the city of Albuquerque. At 1952 hours Sathoud indicated via text message that he had arrived. He then met with the undercover deputies, who appear young, in a room. Sathoud entered the room with the undercover females. The undercover females asked Sathoud if he was here for the "threesome." Sathoud replied, "Yes." During the search incident to his arrest, Sathoud was found to have exactly \$60 in cash on his person.

Sathoud was interviewed on scene and advised of his Constitutional rights as per Miranda to which he stated he understood and advised he would continue talking with Special Agents. During the interview, Sathoud stated that he saw the females on the "POF" app and said hi. He stated that conversation then moved to text messaging. Sathoud stated that the perceived child told him that she was "15." He stated that he believed that to be too young. I asked what agreement was made via text, and he explained that it was initially \$80 and then negotiated to \$60 to "hang out." I asked him about the text where he asked for a "threesome" and he admitted that he did send that. I clarified that he knew a "threesome" to mean sex between three people and he agreed that he did. Sathoud stated that he was not going to do anything and just tell the females that he was too old for them. Sathoud was transported for booking for the listed charges.
